Adam Bradley

Adam is the founder of Lead 'Em Up, a nationally-recognized leadership organization and the co-host of the Hardwood Hustle podcast. Adam had the opportunity to start the Lead 'Em Up program, which provides coaches a dynamic leadership curriculum to use with their players that is currently being used by hundreds of teams all over the country. Locally in the Baltimore/Washington market, Adam serves as the leadership coach for over a dozen teams.

Rick Gorman

Rick has been a major figure in Merrimack Valley Basketball for 30 years. He was the founder and Director of New England Storm basketball AAU program. Rick established the Merrimack Valley Youth Basketball League and served ten years as its President from 2004-2014. Rick is also the founder of the critically acclaimed North Andover Fall Ball League which, for the past 3 years, has provided 20 varsity basketball teams with strong competition and college exposure.

BST Basketball Training has been in operation since 2004 and specializes in basketball training for youth through college. BST stresses fundamental skill development as well as teaching players "how" to play the game in a day and age where players are spending too much time playing meaningless games and not enough time in the gym getting better with proper skill development and realistic game play. Dave Kinsman

West Rutland, MSJ, Rutland boys' basketball coach. Dave is presently the Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Castleton. In 22 years at the varsity level, his teams won 318 games, 11 Final 4s, 5 state finals, and 3 State Championships. Dave has been inducted into the VBCA Coaches Hall of Fame.

Keith Cieplicki

At Rice Memorial, he scored over 2000 points, winning a state title in 1980. At William and Mary, he was All League, forth in career scoring, and led the team to the NIT. Drafted by the Lakers. He coached Rice boys and was the head women's coach at UVM and Syracuse. He is a member of New England Basketball Hall of Fame, Rice Hall of Fame, William and Mary Hall of Fame, and Sports Illustrated Top 50 Vermont Athletes.

Dave Fredrickson

Dave has over 500 wins, 8 State Championships and three New England finals. He is the VBCA Executive Director.
